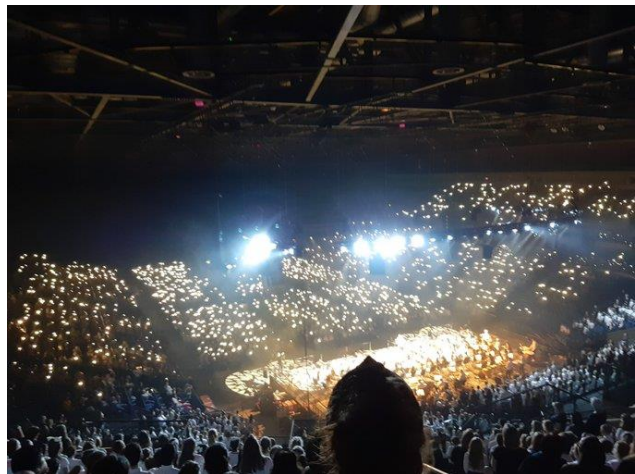

## School Uniform

Can I just remind you for the school rules regarding Jewelry, Hair and Make-up at Rudston.

The wearing of jewellery is not permitted, on grounds of health and safety. This includes rings, bracelets and earrings. Earrings can only be worn if the ears have recently been pierced and plasters must be worn over the ear rings. Watches may be worn but must be sensible watches not novelty ones or phones which can store an image.

Rudston Primary School does not permit 'extreme' haircuts that could serve as a distraction from learning for themselves and other pupils (this includes colours and shaved-in 'logos' or words). **All children, girls and boys, are required to have their hair tied back, if long enough and long fringes need to be clipped back.** We do not allow headwear to be worn during class time or inside school buildings, except for religious or cultural reasons. **Hairclips and hairbands should be plain black, white or maroon and non-decorative - no large flowers, decoration or Jo-Jo style bows.**
