Dear Parents and Carers

Following tonight's announcement by the Prime Minister I am writing to inform you that from Tuesday 5th January (tomorrow) we will be only open to vulnerable and key/critical worker children as we did last summer term during the initial lockdown. Please note that this will be full time (5 days per week) and children of key/critical workers and vulnerable children will be expected to attend school every day.

Please note Bright Stars will currently remain open for all children.

For children not in school, work will be set for children to access remotely via Google Classroom and the same work will be delivered to vulnerable or key/critical worker children who attend school.

If you are a key/critical worker you will be required to provide ID from your place of work when dropping off your child on Tuesday 5th January (tomorrow). This can be work ID or a key worker letter for your employer and must have your full name on it.

Mrs Mulvaney will be contacting the parents of vulnerable children directly.

Arrangements for drop off

During this time it is still vital that we maintain social distancing measures so we will continue to apply our staggered start and end of day routines.

On Tuesday 5th January (tomorrow) parents are asked to enter the school grounds to enable them to confirm their critical/key worker status (produce id) to the key member of staff. Please see the times and locations below.
