## Cave Paintings

Hunter-gatherers often painted and engraved the inside of caves and huts. The Palaeolithic people decorated their cave walls either by carving or engraving them with sharp stones, or by painting them with pigment made from minerals. Rust was obtained from stones that produced a red colour and black came from charcoal. The colours were mixed with water to make paint. They were applied to the walls with either fingers, fur or brushes made from twigs. The pointings often represented daily life such as men hunting, animals and women gathering crops. melloo
