## English in Year 2

- RWI (x5)combined with extended writing time (x 3 )
- 1 independent write per half term
- RWI book is closely matched to their reading level and we explore comprehension linked to the book as well as complete writing tasks.
- Children who have finished RWI have two weekly reading sessions, 1 Spelling session, 1 PAG session and 1 handwriting session. Reading sessions introduce the children to a increasing variety of more challenging texts and give the children opportunity to answer questions about what they are reading
- Expectations of presentation - children will begin to work towards joined handwriting. Please refer to Handwriting Policy on the school website.
- Key text - Humphrey the Lost Whale
- Areas of learning this term - writing a narrative, writing letters.

- Areas of learning this term - Place Value: Numbers to 100, Number Bonds and Number Patterns
Addition and Subtraction: Number bond diagrams, introduce the standard column method
Multiplication of 2,5,10: Multiplication as equal groups, 2, 5, 10 times tables.
- Presentation of work - Children are expected to take care of their workbooks and present their work neatly, numbers orientated correctly.

- Numbots/TT Rock Stars - developing fluency in maths through games. Weekly tasks and competitions set by Mrs Mulvaney.
- Maths Shed \& Spelling Shed - computer based games set weekly. (Monday - Monday). Children are expected to play at least 2 games on each platform.
- Learning Logs (set on Fridays fortnightly) - Link to class work, supports learning. Children share their Learning Logs with classmates. This homework can be presented as writing, drawings, photographs or diagrams. Choose the best way for your child to learn.
