climate crisis	a term describing global warming and climate change, and their impacts.
glacier	A huge mass of ice slowly flowing over a landmass, formed from compacted snow
sea level	an increase in the level of the world's oceans due to the effects of global warming
reverse	To make the effects of climate change turn backwards
global warming	The process of the planet heating up.
climate change	a change in the average conditions — such as temperature and rainfall — in a region over a long period of time.
sustainable	Causing little or no damage to the environment , and therefore able to continue
