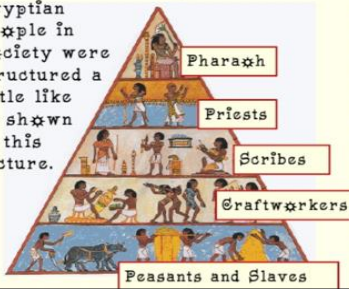

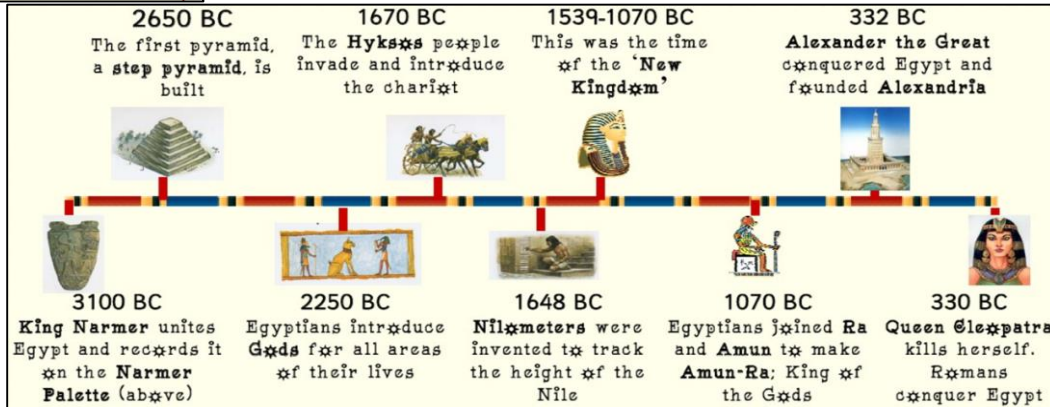
Egyptian people in society were structured a little like is shown in this picture.
