
What was the legacy of the Romans invasion of Britain?



Key Vocabulary	
Celts	Celts lived in Britain from roughly 600BC to 43AD.
Britons	People inhabiting Britain prior to the Anglo-Saxon invasions.
Ancient Rome	A powerful and important civilization that ruled much of Europe for nearly 1000 years.
Invasion	To enter as an enemy, by force, in order to conquer or plunder.
Borders	The line between two countries, counties, or towns.
Centurion	A position in the Roman army (the commander of a century).
Emperor	An emperor is a male who rules an empire.
Empire	A group of countries ruled by a single person, government or country.
Legacy	Something inherited from past generations and passed to future generations.
