I will ask and answer questions, choosing and using parts of stories and other sources to show that I know and understand key features of events.

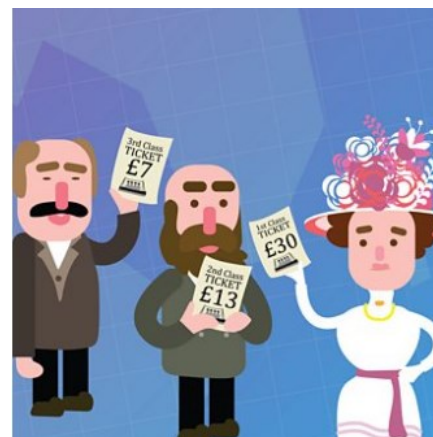
I will be able to distinguish between facts and fiction
